When to Submit

All faculty members requesting a course release should submit the *Course Release Request Form* by November preceding the AY in which the course release is requested. A faculty member may apply at any time before the semester starts due to changes in teaching, research, or service.

Should graduate support be directed to a student outside HASS, the PI should include the rationale on the *Request for Course Release Form*.

Pending Grants

Course releases that are requested using pending grants will not be approved. The faculty member may apply for a course release when the grant is awarded.

Minimum Teaching Load

Each faculty member must teach at least one course per 9-month appointment regardless of course releases.
