

Campus Security Authority (CSA) Report Form

Pursuant to the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act), RPI is required to collect and disclose statistics regarding the occurrence of certain criminal offenses that are reported to college officials designated as a Campus Security Authority (CSA). Additionally, RPI has a responsibility to notify the campus community about any crimes which pose an ongoing threat to the community.

This form is to be completed by a CSA, every time a criminal offense is reported to them, which occurred on campus, in or on non-campus buildings, on property owned or controlled by RPI, or on public property within, or immediately adjacent to, campus. The CSA Report form is a method for CSAs to report Clery Crimes to the Department of Public Safety for the inclusion in the RPI annual compilation of Clery statistics. The CSA Report form is **NOT** a method of notifying police of an emergency, dangerous situation or other hazard. The submission of a CSA Report will **NOT** prompt a police or DPS response or investigation.
